

CERAH Indigenous Peoples' Health & Aging Workshops

In partnership with Indigenous Services Canada (ISC), First Nations & Inuit Health Branch—Ontario region, Lakehead University's Centre for Education and Research on Aging & Health (CERAH) is pleased to offer partial travel reimbursements for the *Learning Essential Approaches to Palliative Care (LEAP) Core Training for Indigenous Communities* workshop in Sioux Lookout, on March 9-10, 2026 **for staff working in Indigenous communities in Northwestern Ontario.**

This workshop can accommodate 30 participants. Spots will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

Travel Details:

Travel arrangements must be ***booked and paid for by training participants directly, or by their Indigenous community/organization.*** This includes flights, mileage, hotels, parking and meals (outside of the workshop). Breakfast, two nutrition breaks and lunch will be provided at the workshop on both days.

Participants must also book and pay for hotels and incidentals directly or through their Indigenous community/organization.

Travel Grant Reimbursements for staff working in Indigenous communities in NWO:

Following the workshop, we will be offering a travel grant to cover ***partial*** travel costs.

- A ***maximum amount of \$750 per person*** has been allocated for participants **driving** in to Sioux Lookout.
- A ***maximum amount of \$2000 per person*** has been allocated for participants **flying** in to Sioux Lookout.

Please note: Travel grant reimbursements will only be provided for people who attend the training. We will not reimburse expenses if a person can no longer attend the training and needs to cancel.
